

Biathlon Committee minutes June 10, 2010

Present: Diane Ramey, Rick McClure, Tom Grenier, Joel Hubbard, and Laurel Dow, Chuck Gilbert, Mike Milhollin.

Called to order: 6:30 pm

1. Approval of minutes of May meeting. Motion to approve, seconded, all in favor.
2. Lead clean up at range. Chuck reported that Dougherty is looking into getting the five gallons or so of contaminated dirt removed and properly disposed of. Chuck is looking into contacting people who know how to deal with the wind blown lead deposits we're finding at the range. Requested clearance to contact NRA regarding how lead is arrested at NRA ranges.

Joel commented that full height wing walls can not be built due to disruption of wind patterns for high level competitions.

Mike M. suggested not using the two end targets during practice.

Joel mentioned that planned storage along the north end of the range could create wind turbulence issues that could impact shot trajectories for some of the firing points. Grenier suggested low trunk like storage might not disrupt wind patterns.

Joel asked for board permission to contact Max Cobb and discuss the issue with Meyer.

Grenier requested a copy of the clean up plan for lead and permission from the board to offer the job in exchange of fee waivers to racer properly trained to do the job. Board passed motion to award fee waiver to racer or family willing to take on the task.

We need an update from Dougherty on the soil disposal before we can move on with rewarding cleaning duties.
