1. **Intrinsic merit of the proposal** (20 points possible)
 - a. **Description** (5 points)
The description of the project is clear and understandable in lay language and goals are easily identified. (0-5) _____
 - b. **Significance** (10 points)
The proposal makes a compelling case for the importance of the project. Specifically identifies gaps that the project intends to fill. (0-10) _____
 - c. **Impact** (5 points)
Demonstrates the distinct contribution this project will make for stopping the cycle of domestic abuse against women and children, as well as, how this project will raise their self-esteem and gain physical and emotional well being through a healthy lifestyle. (0-5) _____

2. **Feasibility of proposal** (20 points possible)
 - a. **Objectives/Timeline** (5 points)
Documents a specific outline of measurable objectives within a defined timeline. (0-5) _____
 - b. **Methods** (5 points)
Applicant establishes a realistic approach and reasonable plan for timely accomplishment of stated goals. Clearly and succinctly describes procedures to be used to accomplish these goals. Survey questionnaires or other tools to be used are attached. (0-5) _____
 - c. **Evaluation Plan** (5 points)
Includes a plan for determining the degree to which objectives will be met. Documents specific criteria to be used to measure the project's success. (0-5) _____
 - d. **Budget** (5 points)
Includes an outline of actual or projected costs for the entire project. All expenses, break-out costs to be met through this request, and those to be provided by the Applicant or other organizations are clear. Demonstrates evidence that the budget is sufficient to meet the objectives of the project described in the narrative. (0-5) _____

3. **Other** (10 points possible)
 - a. **Presentation of Proposal** (5 or 10 points)
Follows required format, including length of proposal. Information is complete; i.e., each item on the rating sheet criteria is addressed. Written in understandable "lay" language and uses correct grammar and spelling. (If you are a previous Beneficiary, maximum value is 5 points; if you are a new Beneficiary, the maximum value is 10 points. (0-5 or 0-10) _____
 - b. **Previous Beneficiary** (5 points)
Fulfilled all Beneficiary requirements of the proposal, end of project reporting to the ASFW Grant Program Committee and other requirements previously agreed to by the Beneficiary. (0-5) _____
