Conditions and Considerations

- NSAA must be on call until race time in case of changing weather.
- The stated fees and services only apply when there is adequate base for snowcat operations. This will be determined by NSAA Operations.
- Classic races will only be set if there is enough base for snowcat use.
- Events during “storm recovery” periods will only go on if the organizer works with NSAA Operations to prepare course. Examples would be shoveling snow and raking sticks.
- This fee schedule only applies to events held on trails regularly groomed by NSAA.
- For non-dedicated events (events other than Nordic skiing) additional fees may apply to repair and/or restore Stadium and course. These events will only take place on the areas with snow making capabilities. Please see attached map to determine course.
- To ensure the success of the event, communication with NSAA Operations is encouraged. This is especially important if the event has any out-of-the-ordinary elements.
- Events must be scheduled at least two weeks in advance.

ALL activities on trails and the stadium require preparation, repair and/or restoration.

Examples of Events

- My club/team/organization would like to host a race. We intend to begin in the stadium or the . Knowing that weather and other conditions are a factor, we will check in with the groomers by calling the grooming bunker the week before our race.
- The stated fees and services only apply when there is adequate base for snowcat operations. This will be determined by NSAA Operations.
