



NSAA Ski Swap Mitigation Plan

October 25, 2020

Goal: Provide a safe atmosphere for community members to participate in a Ski Swap.

All participants and volunteers must follow the terms and conditions of the Mitigation Plan in order to participate.

Location: Outdoors at Wendler Middle School covered ice rink: 2905 Lake Otis Pkwy, Anchorage, AK 99508.

Face Coverings: are required.

Social Distancing: participants must maintain social distancing of 6ft outside of their social “bubble”.

Facilities: There will be no indoor facilities used.

Equipment/Gear:

- If participants would like to try on ski boots, it will be at their own risk.
- Chairs will be sanitized between users.
- Lysol will be on hand to use on boots between users.
- Participants will be encouraged to use hand sanitizer immediately and wash their hands upon exit of the facility.
- Hand washing stations will be available.

Food/Beverage: There will be no food or beverage provided at the event.

Limiting Capacity: Only 50 people will be allowed into the arena at a time.

Screening:

- Staff will be doing verbal symptoms screenings using the following questions of everyone on premise:
 - Have you traveled outside Alaska in the last 14 days?
 - Have you had any close contact with someone COVID-19 positive in the last 14 days?
 - Do you have a fever?
 - Do you have any of the COVID-19 symptoms on the list provided? (see pg 2)
- Participants can choose to scan the QR code to digitally enter their contact information or write it on a clipboard.

Signage: Symptoms of COVID-19 will be displayed and participants will be asked not to participate if they display any of the symptoms in the last 24 hours.

COVID-19 Symptoms:

People with COVID-19 have had a wide range of symptoms reported – ranging from mild symptoms to severe illness. Symptoms may appear 2-14 days after exposure to the virus. People with these symptoms may have COVID-19:

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

This list does not include all possible symptoms.
